### Agenda Item 1- Notice of Meeting

It was confirmed that notice had been given in accordance with: Schedule 12, Paragraph 10 of the Local Government Act 1972.

### Agenda Item 2 - Apologies

Apologies for absence were received from Cllrs. Mrs L. Vullianny and B. Fleming.

### Agenda Item 3 - Declaration of pecuniary and non-pecuniary interests

Cllr. Mrs J. Foreman declared a Non-Pecuniary Interest in Item 6. Planning a) 19/03436 Main Street, Brigham.

### Agenda Item 4 - Minutes Parish Council Meeting

The Minutes of the last meeting of the Council held on 2<sup>nd</sup> October 2019 were read and agreed a true record and signed off by the Chair.

### Agenda Item 5 - Matters Arising

- a. Windfarm Grant - Village Entrance Gates. Mr Martin Flanagan attended the meeting and provided Members with a detailed specification to construct and install 3 Village Entrance Gates to be sited at the approach to Brigham and Foston on the Wolds. It was **AGREED** to accept Mr. Flanagan's quotation of £650 + £100 for concrete wellies to set the posts in the ground. To enable Mr Flanagan to proceed with the project early in the New Year it was also **Agreed** that an advance of £200 be made to cover the costs of initial materials. It was noted that the Parish Council would need to obtain consent from the Highway Authority in order to position the Gates in the Highway. 3 Village Name Plates will be required. Cllr's Mrs Evison and Owen asked to be sent copies of emails to the Highway Engineer. The Chairman thanked Mr. Flanagan for his detailed specification on behalf of the Council and would keep him informed of progress with the ERYC.
- b. Declaration Acceptance & Disclosure of Pecuniary Interest Forms - Cllr. Sellers had completed and returned the above form.
- c. Community Emergency Plan - Cllr O'Connor explained that this matter is still ongoing.
- d. Parish Council Cluster - Councillors Mrs Foreman, Fleming, Watts and O'Connor attended the meeting held in on 10<sup>th</sup> October 2019. ERYC Councillors Mrs Evison, Owen and Lisster together with Mr. P. Bellotti (Director of Communities and Environment) hosted the meeting. The majority of issues involved Highway matters such as speeding, pedestrian safety, parking on double yellow lines and the quality of patching potholes. The new regulations concerning Septic Tanks were

discussed and Cllr. Mrs Evison explained that almost 5,000 properties in the East Riding would be affected. The East Riding Environment and Regeneration Overview and Scrutiny Committee had reported on this matter and agreed to help raise awareness of the changes to the legislation by working with the Environment Agency. It had become clear that Dog Fouling had become a serious issue throughout the area. The role of the 4 Dog Wardens employed by ERYC was outlined. The message received is let the ERYC know details and times when offenders are about. The Councillors were thanked for attending the meeting and for organising the Cluster Meeting.

#### Agenda Item 6 Planning

- a. 19/03436 – Main Street, Brigham To remove about 92mtrs of hedging. It was noted that this Application has been Refused.
  - b. 19/03591/TCA – Cross Keys House, Foston on the Wolds To raise Crown of Willow Tree.
